## NEW Advanced - Long Range Hunter School

DATES: **NEW** Advanced Class – July 19 – 21, 2025 • Arrive July 18 • Depart June 22

This class will be available for the shooter that has already completed the intermediate Hunter class or has previously completed a professional instruction shooting class.

Advanced topics include but not limited to:

Fundamental recap- posing of support hand, eye relief, and trigger.

Hunting/field positioning- tripod/ unsupported techniques.

Wind reading- mirage, terrain features, both speed & direction.

Environmental & wind conditions- effect on elevation corrections.

Advance rifle truing techniques- velocity vs ballistic effects.

Moving Target- speed determination, TOF, measurement, wind correction.



This course is an intense course designed to advance your knowledge and shooting ability with your personal rifle and equipment. While there will certainly be loaner rifles available it is recommended to complete this class with the rifle you plan on using for your long range hunting applications (regardless of caliber or manufacturer).
