

Recommended Hunting Equipment List:

Here are a few quick things we recommend / remind you to bring on your hunt at the Harteis Ranch ~



- Photo ID, Hunting Licenses and Hunters Education/Safety Card
- Cell Phone / Camera + charger.
- Bow & Release along with both hunting and practice arrows / broadheads
- Rifle (with sling & scope cover) + Ammo (20 rounds min.)
- Orange Hat and Vest / Jacket required for all rifle hunts.
- Binoculars / Range Finder (new batteries)
- Waterproof lace up hiking boots (Additional pair of insulated hunting boots and boot gaiters recommended for October & November Rifle Hunts)
- Hunting Jackets (1 lightweight + 1 heavyweight for later seasons)
- Hunting Pants (2 lightweight + 1 mid to heavyweight for later seasons) + Belt.
- Hunting Shirts / Base Layers (2 lightweight long sleeve)
- Hunting Base Layer Bottoms (1pr lightweight for archery / 1pr lightweight + 1pr heavyweight for later seasons)
- Gloves (light + heavyweight for later seasons) / 1 Stocking hat that covers ears (lightweight camo gloves and face mask for archery hunts).
- T-shirts, Socks, Underwear: 3 - 4 pairs each.
- Comfortable Camp Clothing: jeans, sweats, flannel shirts, t-shirts, tennis shoes, etc..
- Slippers for inside Lodge (shoes / boots are not allowed to be worn inside lodge)
- Small Backpack / DayPack (lighter, water bottle, small flashlight or headlamp w/ new batteries, hand warmers, rain jacket, etc..)
- Hygiene kit + necessary vitamins, medications, etc..
- Mitchum or Lume unscented body deodorants (by far the best).
- Unscented body wash / shampoo. (Scent control is very important, please do not bring any scented colognes, perfumes, deodorants, etc. to the ranch.)
- Duffle bag to take on overnight hunts to backcountry cabins and other hunting properties.

Included in your hunt:

Full accommodations; all meals, drinks, snacks and lodging. (including bedding, pillows, and towels)
One on one professional guide service
Transportation while in the field hunting
Field care, gutting, skinning and capping of animal
Orange hat & vest required to be worn while rifle hunting
Scent free washer & dryer for hunting clothing

Not included:

Hunting licenses
Meat processing & shipping fees (Your guides will prepare and transport your animal to a local meat processor). *Only processed meat can be donated!
Taxidermy fees
Alcoholic beverages (ranch will typically have a small assortment)
Travel to and from the Harteis Ranch
Gratuities for Guide and Chef
